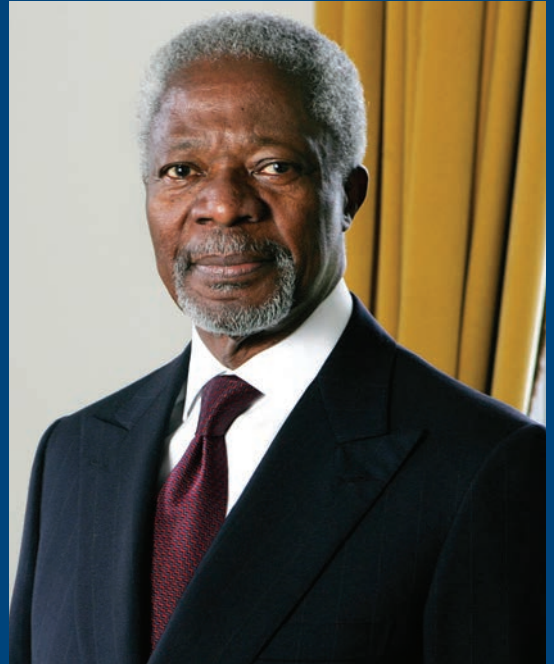

Kofi A. Annan was the 7th Secretary-General of the United Nations and is the founder and chair of the Kofi Annan Foundation. In 2001, he and the United Nations were jointly awarded the Nobel Prize for Peace. He is currently a member of "Board of Directors" at the United Nations Foundation, Chairman of the Board of the Alliance for a Green Revolution in Africa and Chancellor of the University of Ghana. He chairs the African Progress Panel, which advocates at the highest level for equitable and sustainable development in Africa.

Carolyn Miles is the President & Chief Executive Officer for Save the Children. In 2012 alone, the NGO helped more than 125 million children in the United States and in 120 countries around the world.

Siba Shakib is an Iranian filmmaker, writer and political activist. Her film, 'A Flower for the Women of Kabul' was awarded with the first prize for Human Rights Film by the UN and Amnesty International.
